

Route to TivoliVredenburg

In the basement of the venue there is an expedition area located for a maximum of six trucks. This area is in use for all the five halls, and therefore every truck needs to co-operate according the venue's plan. Loading/unloading goods on street level is not possible.

The expedition of TivoliVredenburg has no exact navigation address yet.

To get closest, advice below information.

Navigate to crossroads 'Paardenveld & Catharijnesingel, Utrecht'

For Android use 'Paardenveld 9, Utrecht'

GPS coordinates: 52°05.644 N 5°06.644 E

1. From A12 (Den Haag / Rotterdam / Arnhem)

- At traffic-point Oudenrijn follow direction **Ring Utrecht West**
- Take the exit on the right, direction **Ring Utrecht West**
- Take **exit 8 Jaarbeurs/Centrum**
- At the crossing, go right and cross the bridge onto the *Dr. Martin Luther Kinglaan*
- Follow the direction **Jaarbeurs/Centrum**, name of the road changes to *Weg Der Verenigde Naties*
- Follow this street, names changes again into *Graadt van Roggeweg*
- Follow the road across *Westplein*
- Turn right, go through the *Daalsetunnel*, **follow the map or the photos on the right from now on**

2. From A2 (Amsterdam / 's Hertogenbosch)

- Follow the **A2**, direction **Utrecht**
- Take **exit 8**, direction **city centre**
- At the crossing, go right and cross the bridge onto the *Dr. Martin Luther Kinglaan*
- Follow the direction **Jaarbeurs/Centrum**, name of the road changes to *Weg Der Verenigde Naties*
- Follow this street, name changes again into *Graadt van Roggeweg*
- Follow the road across *Westplein*
- Turn right, go through the *Daalsetunnel*, **follow the map or the photos on the right from now on**

3. From A27 (South: Gorinchem)

- Turn right at traffic-point *Everdingen* to the A2, direction **Utrecht-West/Amsterdam**
- Follow this road across the bridge (*Jan Blanken brug*)
- From no follow route 1 (From A12 (Den Haag / Rotterdam / Arnhem)

4. From A27 (North: Hilversum)

- Follow **Ring Utrecht Zuid** and get to the **A12**
- On the A12, follow the direction **Ring Utrecht West** onto the A2
- Take **exit 8 Jaarbeurs/Centrum**
- At the crossing, go right and cross the bridge onto the *Dr. Martin Luther Kinglaan*
- Follow the direction **Jaarbeurs/Centrum**, name of the road changes to *Weg Der Verenigde Naties*
- Follow this street, names changes again into *Graadt van Roggeweg*
- Follow the road across *Westplein*
- Go through the *Daalsetunnel*, **follow the map or the photos on the right from now on**

5. From A28 (Amersfoort)

- At traffic-point Rijnsweerd, go left onto the **A27**, direction **Gorinchem**
- Follow **Ring Utrecht Zuid** and get to the **A12**
- On the A12, follow the direction **Ring Utrecht West** onto the A2
- Take **exit 8 Jaarbeurs/Centrum**
- At the crossing, go right and cross the bridge onto the *Dr. Martin Luther Kinglaan*
- Follow the direction **Jaarbeurs/Centrum**, name of the road changes to *Weg Der Verenigde Naties*
- Follow this street, names changes again into *Graadt van Roggeweg*
- Follow the road across *Westplein*
- Turn right, go through the *Daalsetunnel*, **follow the map or the photos on the right from now on**



Turn right and go through the Daalsetunnel.
You're almost there!
Take the **right lane**
Go **right** on the T-junction



Make a left here, and go over the water. After that, you'll see the **slope** towards our expedition hall on your **right**. **Apply yourself at the reception via the red intercom at top of the slope**



Maximum height for the TivoliVredenburg expedition entrance is **4 meters / 13.1 feet / 157 inches**.

If applicable, after load out put the car in the lowest position before exiting the loading dock.

6. Environmental zone

The city center of Utrecht (which includes the area around TivoliVredenburg) has a designated environmental zone, starting January 1st 2015. In order to reduce air pollution caused by diesel soot, only cars and delivery vans that meet certain emission standards are allowed to be driven in this zone. Diesel vehicles built before 2001 are not allowed to enter the environmental zone and risk a penalty.

These new emission standards do not apply to trucks or sleepercoaches.
